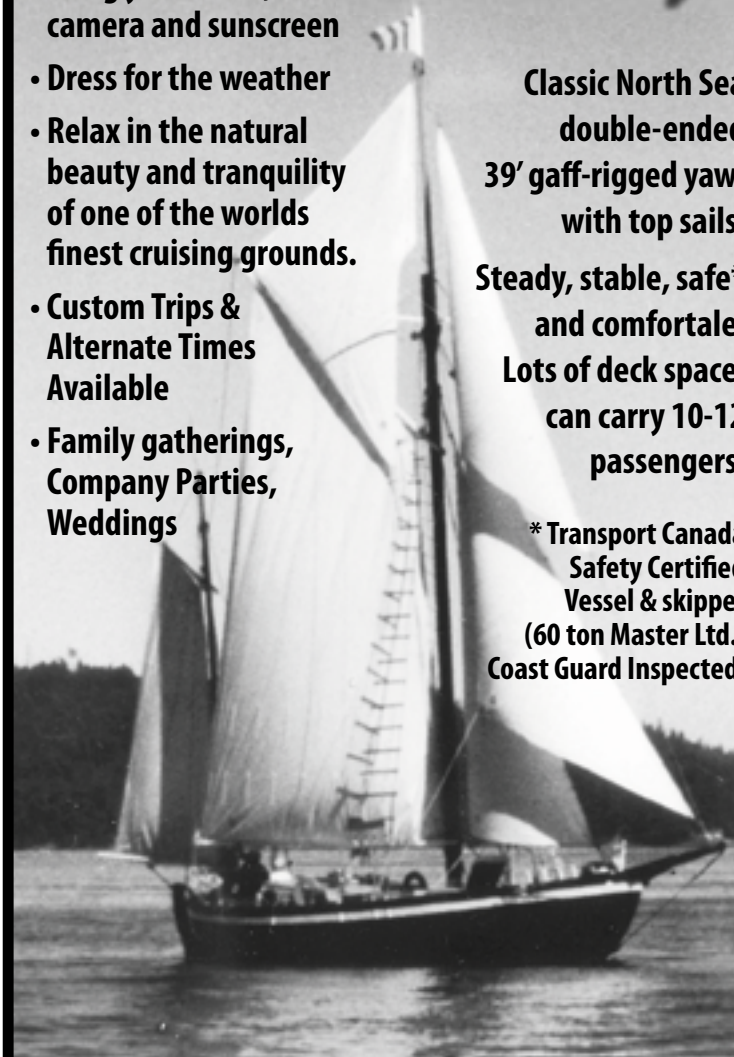

More on Solving The Affordable Housing Crisis

Dear Editor

Thank you for posting in your previous edition, the letter about our shortage of affordable rental units. I personally don't understand the logic being employed by some people and possibly the Islands Trust trustees that must be present for this problem to remain unsolved. My lack of understanding could be because I have only lived here for 20 months. From my short time living here, I do think that most people would support car pooling and public buses that utilize vehicles for more than just single riders. These are concepts that involve greater utilization of assets for the public good. What I don't understand is why some people have a problem letting people with extra space create affordable rental units. Is our society better off with having homeless people who have jobs remain homeless or be forced to live in squalid rental units? Currently, our island is forcing people to live in poor conditions like shacks, moldy broken down mobile homes and other substandard rentals that should be condemned and are fire hazards. However, liberalizing affordable rental suites is only a small part of the solution to having enough affordable rental units.

What is required is the creation of probably 50 to 100 new affordable rental units. Why are we putting the lives of the people who perform valuable services on this island at such huge risks? Why is the current form of governance on this island such that we even have this problem? Why wasn't it solved years ago? Why do I hear that the same comments and discussions keep reoccurring year after year? Whether we are governed by Islands Trustees, or municipal government officials, what we need is to have our elected officials solve this problem NOW, or to move over and let someone else with the will and compassion to take over, solve it. As far as I am concerned, our Islands Trustees are either part of the solution or the problem. The current persisting situation would suggest that if they don't solve it immediately, then they are the problem. I haven't been here long enough to know the answer but I do hear the cries of the people to their elected officials and so far nothing has happened except for a handful of units on Rainbow Road that probably has more to do with Mr. Murakami's benevolence and unwavering persistence than anything else. How long did our local officials put up road blocks on the Murakami project

until it was actually approved? How many other Murakami's are out there willing to take years off their lives to fight for the right to help solve the problem? Instead, why aren't our elected officials asking people for proposals to solve this problem? Shouldn't our elected officials be rolling up their sleeves to sit down and immediately create a fast track approval process? Why don't we have a document from our elected officials telling us exactly what they would agree to in terms of supporting an affordable housing development for 2008?

As long as we have a form of government that doesn't have the wherewithal to create a process for allowing fast track approval for higher density affordable rental units, we will never solve the affordable housing problem. I believe that this housing problem will only get worse as more people will be needed for low paying service jobs. Some think that the island should try to find ways to keep the island from growing. I don't think it is possible. Some of us want to see more business activity here so that our children will not have to leave the island in order to find good jobs. Only a growing economy can provide that.

The Islands Trust has done a great job in conserving and protecting land. However, the current situation leads to illegal suites for those who want to help, which means there is no inspection by CRD for fire and other important code violations putting many people at risk. Do we need out and out civil disobedience to have those in authority change the system? Or do we just sit by and watch them continue to "study the problem" without any action to help alleviate the problem that exists right NOW?

As a developer and builder, I know affordable housing units (without the need for public funds) could be created that would rent for \$600 to \$1000 per month along with some condo units that would sell for under \$200,000. However, this could only happen through the allowance of creating higher density for affordable housing projects. This is because land costs are very expensive here and only by allowing land to hold multiple units would the cost be affordable to build and rent. However, this type of development won't happen because any proposed development would have to invest a lot of time and money just to put a plan together and they might have to wait years to find out if the plan would get the approval from local authorities. It is hard to

You don't miss your water "till your well runs dry and Islanders may be hard pressed to find people to serve them. Renting at the whim of owners and their prices and decisions as to when they want you in and out is not fair. It is not fun to pay a large sum to look after someone's property for them while they are away. Renting here is next door to being homeless. We can no longer carry on with the same mindset developed in the past decades. How about our federal and provincial governments providing grants to property owners to build an extra living space for workers and then giving them the option to buy after 5 years of renting and a portion of their rent paid over the years going to the purchase price? Co-op housing also need a revival.

It makes me wonder why people concerned about the well being of our lower income residents don't understand why some people want a municipal council. With a municipal council, one could take a plan to the council, have a zoning meeting and proceed or find out exactly what is required to proceed, as Municipalities have their obligations to hold regular public hearings on any development plan and all the decision makers would be locals elected to public office. Perhaps the Islands Trust could be reformatted to have this kind of public accountability and transparency with respect to how we go about this kind of process. Whatever governance we end up with, doesn't mean that there will be runaway uncontrolled development as elected officials always have the right to make sure that any development is in the public interest.

We don't have to have people living here in infested and broken down fire hazards. We are a prosperous island with many caring and compassionate people. Every day I drive around this island noticing the thousands of acres of forested lands that are protected and wonder how we got to the point that we seem more concerned with taking care of our lands than our people.

Living peacefully with nature

You know it's time to be a bit suspicious when people give you lots of advice, but no solution to a problem.

Take, for example, when it was discovered that otters had moved in under our cabin.

We had watched the playful creatures swim, fish and chatter from our deck. They were a lovely source of entertainment. But then it started to smell like a cannery near our front door. A very strong rotten fish odour that wouldn't go away, even during a windstorm.

Shortly thereafter, one of our cats began showing signs of distress. I took him to a local vet, who after a thorough physical examination and an unusual line of questioning determined that we had otters living under our floor. The cat had developed a stress ulcer. He was freaked out by the invisible noisy, stinky creatures that were very busy nesting under the kitchen floor, directly under his food dish.

Our poor kitty was put on medications and the otters had to go. So, off I went looking for an answer.

I asked neighbours, I went to the local gardening centre, I attended an "Otter Talk" hosted by the Conservancy, I had advice ranging from here-say to the scientific, but all were prefaced with "this might work."

Spread lime around, no, moth balls are better. Male urine is a strong deterrent. Wire mesh, spikes, noise...

The best idea: learn to live with them.

Eventually the cat mellowed out. The otters

finished nesting, spending less time under the cabin and more time in the ocean, teaching their babies how to swim.

This offered us hours of entertainment. The little otters did not take to the sea. They coughed and sputtered having breathed in too much water. They moved on the shore, mewed in protest as their parents tried to coax them back in. After a few days, the young otters were swimming happily. We felt fortunate to have watched this slice of nature play out before our eyes.

We have since moved to a new place, complete with a veggie garden, lots of shrubs, and a small orchard. One side of the property is forested, and in the back is a wildflower meadow.

A perfect place for a deer to hang out.

And, like the otters, entertaining to watch, until she started eating the plants.

I wasted no time and set off, looking for an answer to my latest animal challenge.

There was lots of advice to solving this very common problem. I found numerous magazine articles on the subject, the internet sold products galore, and the gardening centre offered a list of deer resistant plants. Use flags, the colour yellow, fuzzy leafed plants, special spray, high fencing... I began to have a sneaking suspicion that there was no fool-proof answer.

Besides, this winter, on a trip to the East Kootenays, I had seen a deer chewing on a turkey drumstick at the dump, another at a compost pile crunching a crab leg, and one



picking up a pizza crust along the side of a busy road. Had these gentle herbivores crossed over to the carnivore camp? There is no predicting their behaviour.

I decided to fence in some of the more prized plants and leave the others as decoys for the deer to enjoy. Like the ultimate otter solution: learn to live with them.

Now, when I look out into the back meadow, my eyes briefly meet with the deers, as she sits contentedly in the grass, surrounded by delicious flowers and tender green leaves. Fortune continues to smile on us. I guess I found the answer after all.

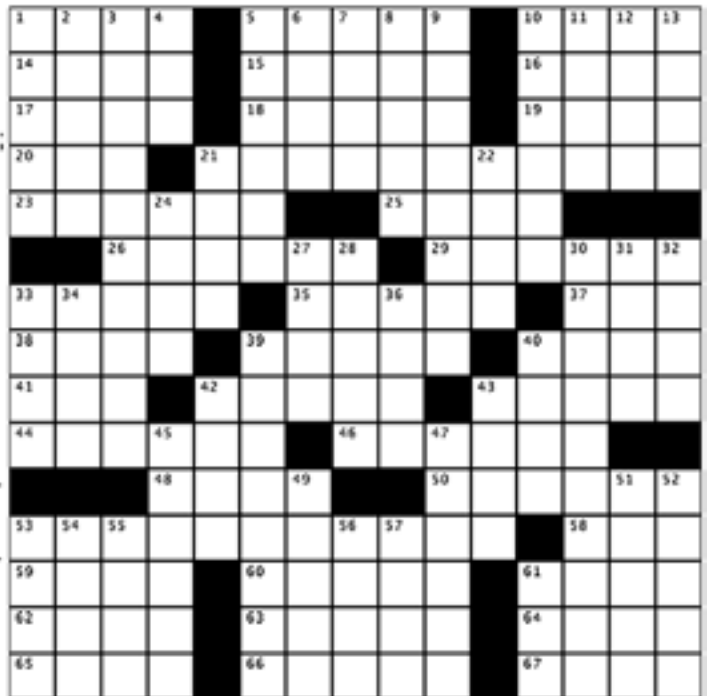

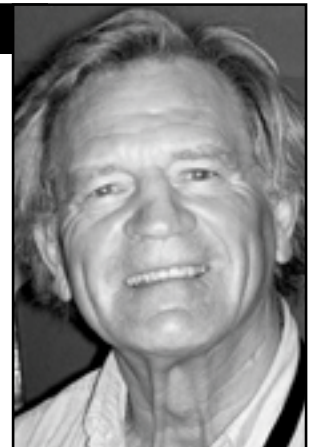

Place your feeder close to bright flowers, like impatiens, fuchsias, petunias or geraniums. If you do not think there is enough red on your feeder try tying a bright red ribbon on it.

Keep your feeder well cleaned and change the nectar every 4 days. Black spots inside the feeder indicates mold and it needs to be cleaned out with a bottle brush. If that does not work try shaking sand and water inside it to remove the mold. Don't use harsh detergent. Rinse it out with hot water every time to you change the feeder.

You only need to fill it half full, as they seldom will drink it all before it needs to be changed.

NECTAR RECIPE:

You don't need to buy commercial "hummingbird food". You can simply boil 1 part regular sugar and 4 parts water for 2 minutes. Store the remaining nectar in the fridge or freezer. Don't use red food colouring, honey or artificial sweeteners.


If you enjoy watching these little wonders in your back yard, maintain your feeder all through the summer months and they will be back for more.



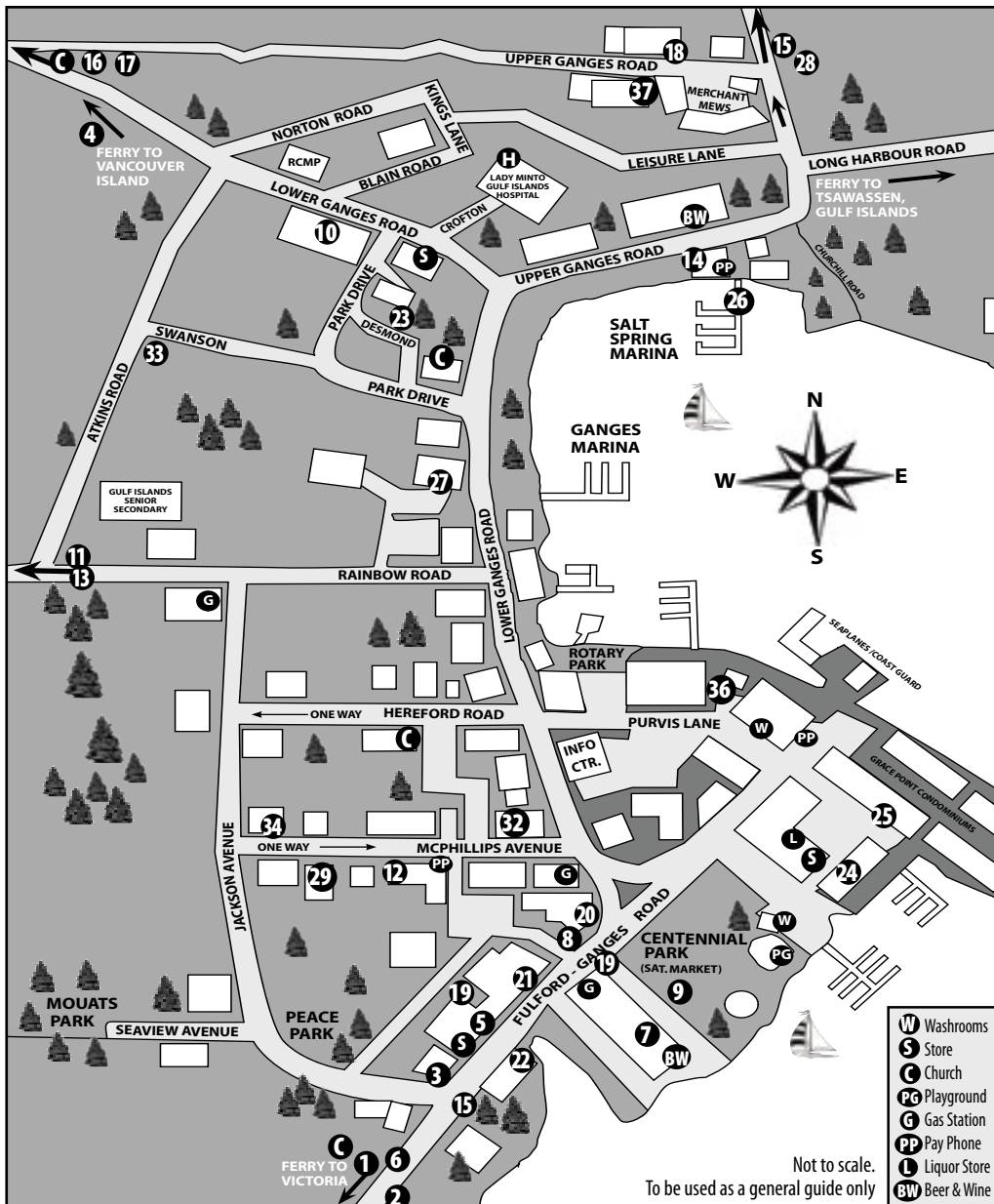
