Keeping it Reehl

This past weekend for Mother's Day at Moby's I prepared a special meal of Honey Glazed Cornish Hen that was enjoyed, and I wondered about how and where these tasty little gourmet birds came from.

Well, it turns out that a Cornish Game Hen is not a game bird at all. They were bred in Connecticut in the 1950's. A retired artist and his wife began experimenting with chickens to raise a small plump bird with all white meat that was ideal for single serving. They crossed Cornish Game chickens from England with local breeds like the White Plymouth Rock hen to create a new breed that in 4 to 6 weeks weighs about 2.5 pounds with lots of white breast meat.

Today they are popular and they sell in the millions and all of us love the juicy tasty white meat and the gamy flavour. They say the gamy flavour is because of the special diet they are fed.

In Connecticut they are raised with a high protein diet which consists of cranberries, acorns and different nuts. In the US, most of them come from one company and are shipped frozen all over the world.

You know what!!!! It is pretty hard to find fresh Cornish Game hens, I have always had to purchase them frozen and let them thaw out and then roast them. Delicious!

There are lots of great recipes for these small gourmet delights. Here is one that I like.

Cornish Game Hens with Garlic and Rosemary

INGREDIENTS:

| | |
|-------------------------|--------------------------------|
| 4 Cornish game hens | salt and pepper to taste |
| 1 lemon, quartered | fresh rosemary, thyme and sage |
| 3 tablespoons olive oil | 24 cloves garlic |
| 1/3 cup white wine | 1/3 cup chicken broth |

DIRECTIONS:

Preheat oven to 450 degrees F (230 degrees C).

Rub hens with 1 tablespoon of the olive oil.

Mix 2 tablespoons minced fresh garlic, 2 teaspoons finely chopped fresh thyme, 2 teaspoons finely chopped fresh rosemary, and 2 teaspoons finely chopped sage. Loosen the breast skin of each hen and rub one quarter of the mixture under the skin of each bird.

Lightly season hens with salt and pepper. Place 1 lemon wedge and 1 sprig rosemary in cavity of each hen. Arrange in a large, heavy roasting pan, and arrange garlic cloves around hens. Roast in preheated oven for 25 minutes.

Reduce oven temperature to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C). In a mixing bowl, whisk together wine, chicken broth, and remaining 2 tablespoons of oil; pour over hens. Continue roasting about 15-20 minutes longer, or until hens are golden brown and juices run clear. Baste with pan juices every 10 minutes.

Transfer hens to a platter, pouring any cavity juices into the roasting pan. Tent hens with aluminum foil to keep warm. Transfer pan juices and garlic cloves to a medium saucepan and boil until liquids reduce to a sauce consistency, about 6 minutes. Cut hens in half lengthwise and arrange on plates. Spoon sauce and garlic around hens. Garnish with rosemary sprigs, and serve.

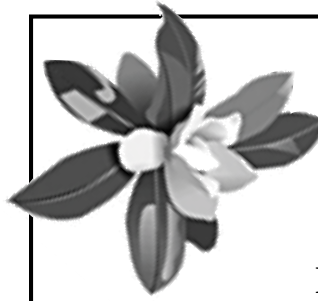

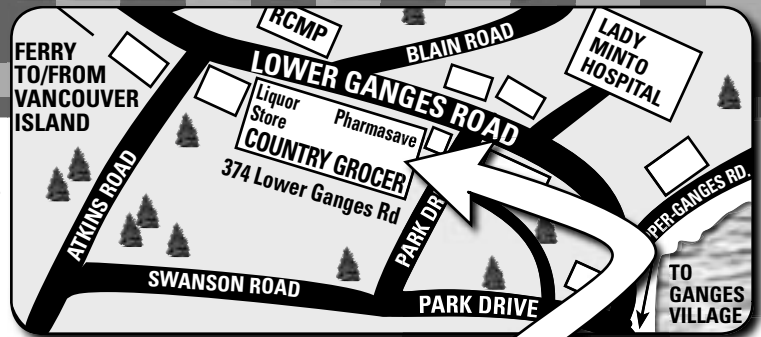
