Aerial Circus Production Set to Fly High: The Dharma According to Fifi

Prepare for high-flying interactive drama...

Flying Dreams Aerial Arts Productions and the Aerial Arts Theatre Society are set to open their third season on Salt Spring Island with the August 13th premiere of *The Dharma According to Fifi*, another in a series of original contemporary aerial circus productions that have taken the Gulf Islands by storm. Playing to sell out houses, the “wondrously staged” offerings of this unique nouveau cirque production company, have become one of the most popular live theatrical events in the Gulf Islands.

Company artistic director Victoria Mihalyi is the writer, choreographer, and ultimately creator of the high-flying avant-garde circus show. And she is quick to point out this is not traditional circus, or styled in the more modern tradition of Cirque du Soleil. “Most of our shows are narratives, so we draw a carefully crafted story and integrate the aerial acts in a more organic way,” says Mihalyi. “Our venue is much more intimate, so the shows are more interactive.” Audience members are sometimes close enough to reach out and touch performers, and if you’re in the front row, be prepared to be buzzed by flying acrobats directly overhead with heart-stopping aerial stunts being performed 30 feet up in the air.

It’s the “indelicate” tale of a washed-up old circus star put out to pasture who finds herself selling popcorn in a concession stand. Humiliated, Fifi runs away from the circus, and at the invitation of Father Rufus Valentino, a maverick Jesuit priest who has annoyed

the ‘Big Boys’ in Rome, she takes refuge in a little church on a hill ... with nice high ceilings. It’s a whimsical romantic comedy that rides on the clash of two different worlds; the elite society of a Catholic theologian, and the freakish world of an old-time circus performer who takes pride in her seriously skewed Buddhist ideals.

In a departure from past large-scale productions, this show features only two performers: Victoria taking on the role of Fifi, and Anthony Ulc as Rufus Valentino. Ulc starred in the lead role of Diamond Dick in the sensational 2008 hit show *Speakeasy*. An accomplished actor, he has appeared in several films, in theatrical productions in Vancouver and on Salt Spring Island, and numerous television shows including *McGyver*, *Sentinel*, *Outer Limits*, and *Stargate*. ZUCCHINI CELEBRATION!

The bounty of our garden is starting to roll in and this year things look really good. But of all the vegetables that are ripening, it looks like the champion harvest is going to be Zucchini!!

Sound familiar? Well, we already have zucchini coming out our ears and I am scrambling to find something to do with this delicious and prolific plant. I can't seem to give them away fast enough. I thought that maybe you, as well, have had a bumper crop of this delightful vegetable with its huge green leaves and bright yellow flowers, so I thought some tips and suggestions might help you out. Interestingly enough the health benefits of Zucchini include carotenoids, magnesium, potassium, copper and phosphorous. It is rich in Vitamin C, A, K, and B vitamins. It is also beneficial for the heart, perhaps preventing heart attacks and stroke. Studies have shown that Zucchini could prevent age-related prostate enlargement. It also has antioxidant nutrients. beneficial in inflammatory diseases such as arthritis and asthma.

Here are some interesting ideas for your bountiful zucchini crop.

FREEZING ZUCCHINI

Start with the prime zucchinis. Best to use the young squash with dark green color and no blemishes, wrinkles or soft spots. Wash them, but do not peel them. If you want to use frozen zucchini in soups or breads, you can grate it and then freeze it, ready to add to your favourite recipe. If you want to fry zucchini later, you can cut it into 1/4" to 1/2" slices, ready to be thawed, battered and fried. For casseroles, I like to chop zucchini before freezing into 1" to 2" cubes.

My experience is that it is best to freeze zucchini without steaming or blanching because when you cook it after thawing it, it becomes too soggy and mushy. But, you may want to steam the zucchini. If you do, do not immerse it in water, but just put it in a strainer above the boiling water for 2 1/2 to 3 minutes from the time your water boils. Then place it immediately in cold water and drain off any excess water and dry. Place them in zip lock freezer bags. Zucchini doesn't need extra water in cooking, as it has plenty of moisture just from the squash itself. Frozen zucchini can last from 9 to 14 months and can be used in many of your favourite recipes, like pasta sauces, lasagne, chilli, meat loaves, soups or breads and muffins

ZUCCHINI FRITTERS RECIPE:

1 large zucchini, finely chopped
1 small onion, chopped
3 eggs, beaten
1/2 cup freshly grated Romano or Parmesan cheese
1 cup milk

2 cups all-purpose flour
1/4 cup vegetable shortening
You can also add garlic and onion powder, and salt and pepper to taste
Mix the zucchini, onion, eggs, cheese, milk and flour into a large bowl. Add seasonings and parsley. Heat 2 tablespoons of shortening in a large frying pan on the stove turned to medium. Ladle 1/4 cups of the batter into the pan and flatten a little bit. Like pancakes, turn the fritters over when the center seems to be dry. Cook them until they are a golden brown. Set them aside and keep warm with a little butter added to them. Enjoy!

ZUCCHINI CHIPS

Slice or cut into strips. Baste in milk and then place them into flour flavoured with salt and pepper and a little basil. When you think the hot oil is ready, try one piece first. The oil should be hot enough on medium high...too hot will brown or burn the zucchini too fast. Watch them closely until they are golden brown and strain and place them on a paper towel. You are in for a treat!!

With a little planning, effort and luck your family can enjoy that bountiful harvest with some unique and delicious menu ideas, and that frozen zucchini will taste good this coming winter.

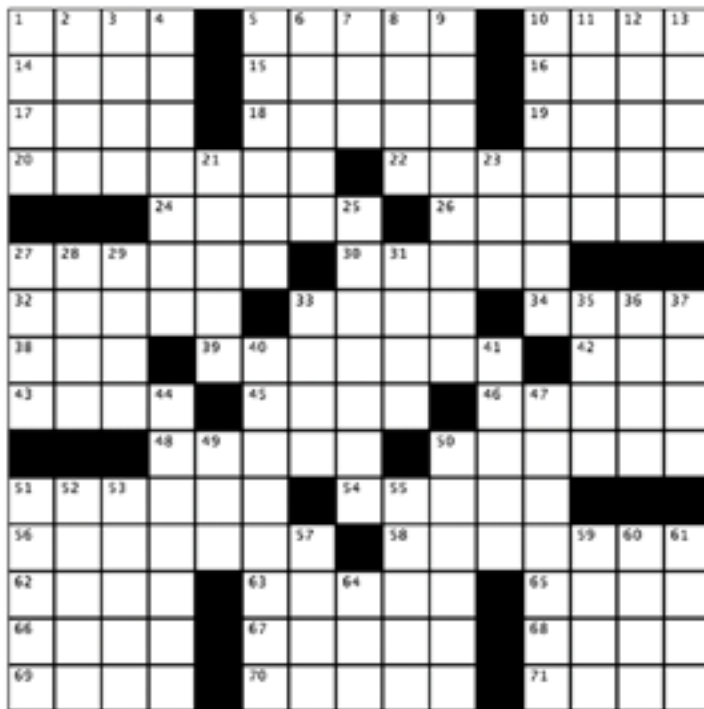
