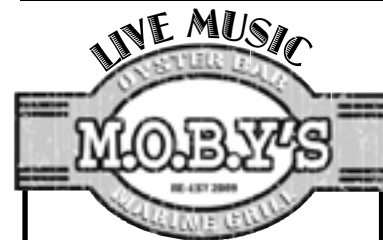

- 1 cup cream (double whipped)

CARAMEL TOPPING

- 3 tablespoon water
- 1 cup 7oz caster sugar

To make topping, place water and sugar in a heavy - based saucepan and cook over medium heat, stirring until sugar dissolves. Bring mixture to the boil and boil without stirring until sugar syrup is a golden brown. Swirl pan once or twice during cooking.

2. Arrange Pawpaw, Mango, Kiwi, Strawberries and Blackberries on individual serving plates, top with cream and spoon over topping.

Serve immediately. Serves about 4 people.

OTHER IDEAS:

4 cups of Blackberries in a pan add 5 tablespoon of water and 3 tablespoon of sugar(optional) stew for about 3 to 5 minutes, serve with Ice cream.

Homeopathy Walk-in clinic Reopens for a second year

“We found the service to be of such value for people wanting to explore holistic medicine as a means to address their acute health concerns; it seems only natural to continue to offer it again for another year”, adds Beviere.



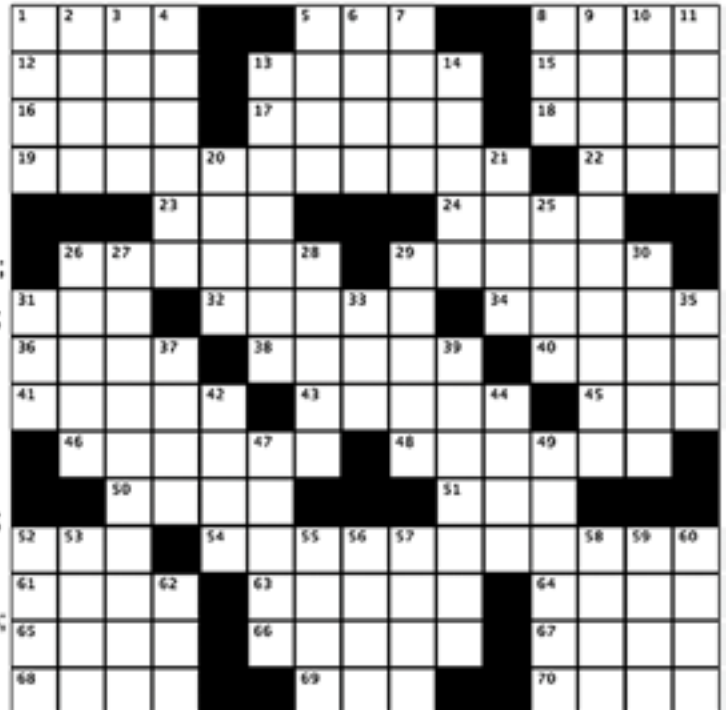

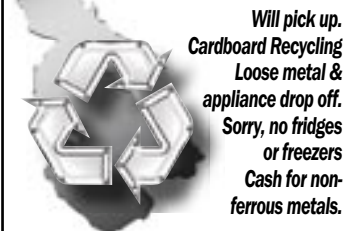
